Other information: Just a few steps and you are immediately immersed in the rarefied atmosphere of this soulful place. It is said that the first Christian worship with the Byzantine rite was celebrated in this cave. Saints with oriental features seem to greet the modern visitor inviting him to ponder the sacredness of these walls where legends mix with water in the ancient well. It is here that Saint Peter quenched his thirst with just the sign of the cross and broke the pagan simulacrum that rose alongside it.

To start this journey back in time that many times has risked oblivion, you literally descend from the noble rooms of the 18th-century Delli Ponti mansion to the hypogeal area that preserves traces of the Greek walls and tombs hewn in the rock and arcosolium. Vertically returning through history, the first floor of the building opens with the extensive expanse of the hall, the 18th-century altar and the breath-taking view of the Mar Piccolo (Little Sea).

Information about Puglia Open Days 2014: Casa Pezzolla Local History Museum was named after its ancient owner who lived in the second half of the 18th century; doctor Giacomo Pezzolla, personal physician of the Aragonese counts of Acquaviva.

The museum consists of two sections featuring different architectural styles: the more modern section, spread over two floors, presents a high and narrow facade surmounted by a gable which opens onto the section of the double-pitched roof clad with chiancarelle limestone tiles; the other section represents the older wing of the museum. This is built with simpler and smaller architectural elements, mostly ashlar, showing all those characteristics typical of a trullo. Contrary to the modern section, the old section walls are built with unsquared stones laid in a random pattern.
